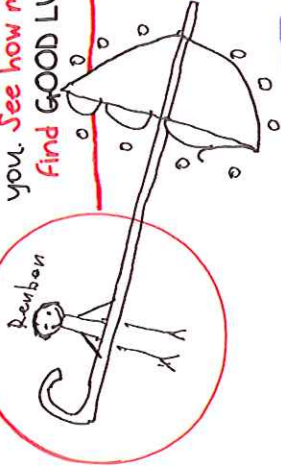


Young Explorers Map

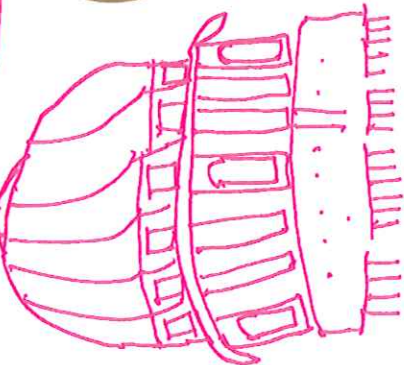

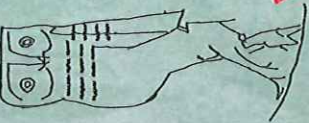

5. Can you find the sphinx hiding in the South Transept? A sphinx isn't a real animal - it is a mythical creature with the head of a human and the body of a lion.



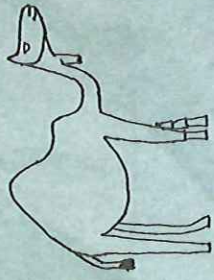
4. This part of the Cathedral is called the American Memorial Chapel. Carved into the decoration are lots of North American birds. This owl is my favourite. Can you find it?
