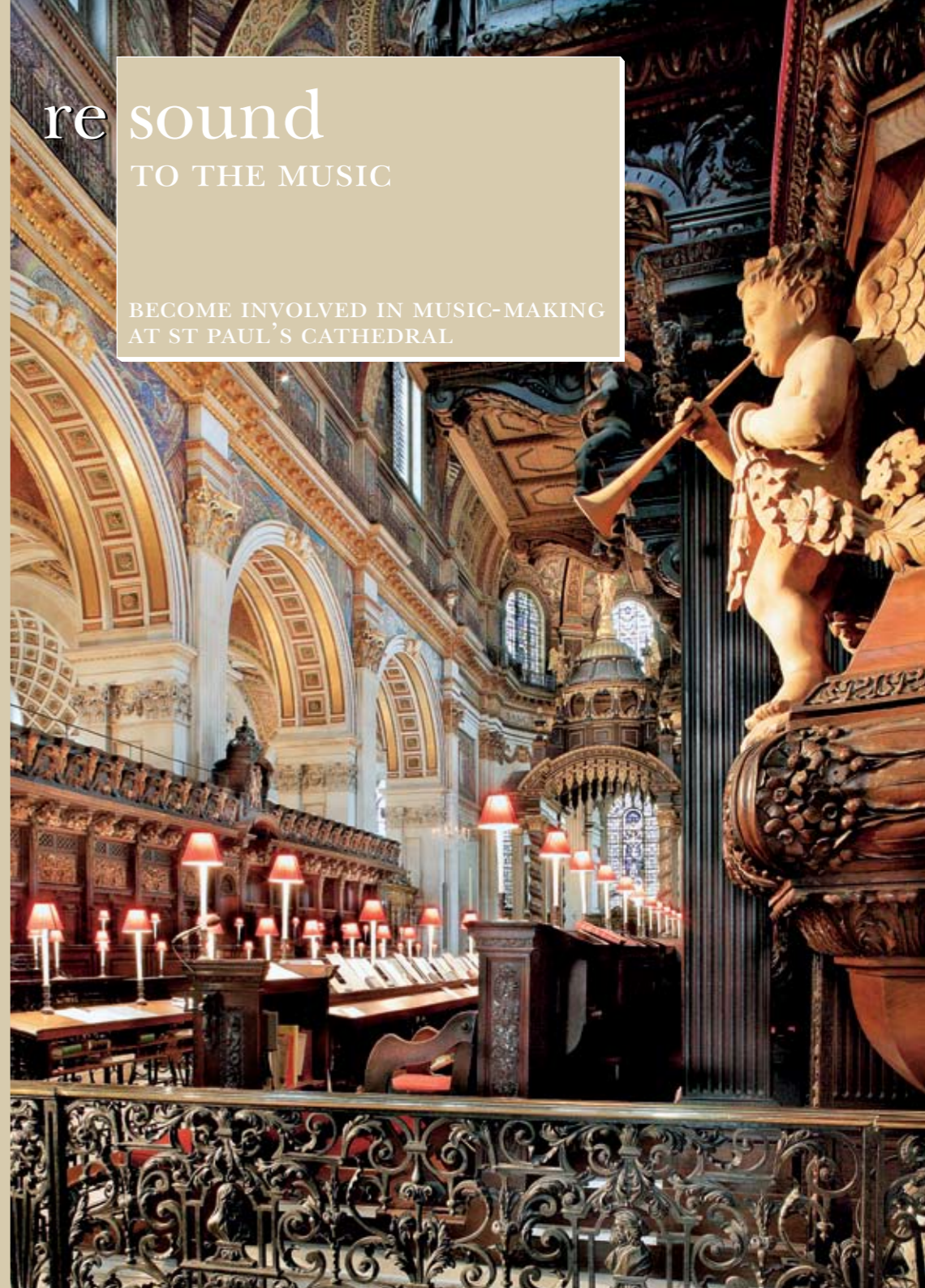

St Paul's resounds with the thrilling majesty of the superb Grand Organ with its 7,256 pipes, 108 stops and 5 manuals. In 2008, for the first time and thanks to a single generous benefactor, a second mobile console will be in use. With its origins in the legendary organ-building skills of Father Smith and Father Willis, the St Paul's Organ has just undergone its 30-year restoration by Manders costing £1 million. Mendelssohn and Handel played the St Paul's organ; Jeremiah Clarke of 'Trumpet Voluntary' fame was Organist of St Paul's in the early 1700s; the St Paul's musical pantheon includes Maurice Greene, Thomas Attwood, John Goss and John Stainer. We need to build on this fine tradition and perpetuate it long into the future.

St Paul's Cathedral in London is the nation's cathedral, the City of London's church and Wren's architectural masterpiece. It is also the home of the largest musical foundation in the UK with its 40 boy choristers, 18 professional Vicars Choral and 3 Organists under a Director of Music. Music supports the liturgical life of St Paul's at some 1,700 services every year, including sublime daily Choral Evensongs, in addition to numerous magnificent State and City occasions, concerts and recordings.

To maintain this provision, and to the highest possible standards, the Dean and Chapter's financial commitment to music is a substantial one – professional fees and assistance with chorister tuition costs some £1 million a year.

Just one new set of anthems costs in the region of £250.

The current cost of a choristership is £12,000 p.a. usually for 5 years.

How you can help

With a minimum commitment of £10 a week, £500 a year, you can become a Music Patron of St Paul's. As a Music Patron you can expect to get more involved in music-making at the Cathedral; we will reserve seats for you at special musical occasions throughout the year and keep you informed on what is coming up; there will be occasions when we will arrange for you to meet the musicians and go behind the scenes.
