

Inclusive Multimedia Guide at St Paul's Cathedral

What is the multimedia guide?

The touch-screen multimedia guide offers audio and visual material including a spoken commentary, images, short excerpts from films, as well as music. It lasts for up to 90 minutes and is self-led.

- Increase knowledge and engagement for all our visitors.
- Offer increased interpretation for those visitors who do not speak English and for those who have accessibility difficulties.
- To improve the visitor experience by offering better value for money to our visitors.



Who is eligible to receive a multimedia guide?

The multimedia guide is available to all FIT'S (free independent travellers). Groups with group leaders or guides are eligible for the Group Tour System.

What languages is the multimedia tour available in?

English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, **Portuguese**, Russian, Polish, Korean, Japanese, Mandarin.

Do I need to pay extra or book in advance?

No, there is no extra cost for either the multimedia guide or Group Tour System. There is also no need to book in advance. The multimedia guide is distributed upon arrival at the cathedral and no deposit or identification is required to take the equipment.
