


# FAMILY SUMMERTRAIL


What animal is on the top of the Wellington memorial?

How many colours can you see on it? Write that in the star. Count the shapes and look for patterns in the brass, shiny centre.


# Now look up into the **dome...**

Sir Christopher Wren designed St Paul's after the old cathedral burned down in the Great Fire of London. What year was the Great Fire? When you go downstairs to the crypt, watch the film about it in the OCULUS film room.

To your left, a side chapel, The Light of the World. →

Henry Moore's Mother & Child Sculpture.



Not far from the sculpture... huge gates! Go through them...




When you are through the gates **find these things...**

Go through the gates to the opposite side aisle and

Look for symmetrical angels and patterns.


Look at the patterns in the arches up there too!

**Lord Nelson's tomb...look for** the cushion and crown on the top!

Page 1. There is one lion on each lamp stand. There are twelve lions around Wellington's memorial. Total: 14 lions!

The animal on top of Wellington's memorial is a horse. This was his war horse.

Page 2. We'll leave you to count those star points & colours under the dome AND the number of windows up in the dome...ha ha!

There are 8 stone pillars holding up the dome arches.

The dome is a circle shape—although the dome itself is a hemisphere of course!

The Great Fire broke out in September 1666!

Page 4 Florence Nightingale is nursing a dying soldier in the Scutari hospital, during the Crimean war and is giving him a glass of water.
