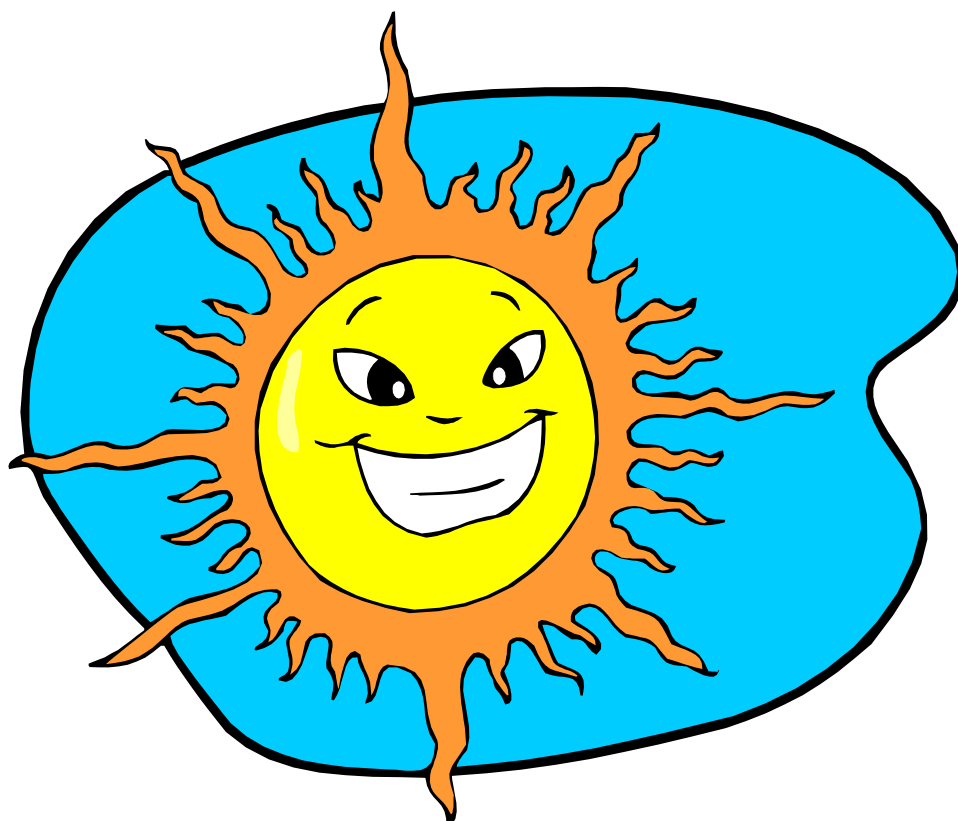


FAMILY SUMMER TRAIL

It is a very special place of prayer and worship for Christians. We also welcome people from many different world faiths. **All are welcome!**

CAN YOU FIND THESE THINGS?

They are all in the large area around you and in front of you called the *NAVE*. Tick the boxes when you find them.



Psst...you might see different patterns carved in the stone work all around you!

Next step...

GO AND STAND UNDER THE DOME!

YOU ARE STANDING BY THE GREAT WEST **DOORS...AREN'T THEY HUGE?**

Can you see this?



It is the FONT. This is where Christians are baptised.



Lion Clue.. Find two tall lamp stands near the font, and spot the lions...then find **the Duke of Wellington's** memorial to see how many lions surround it! Put the total number in the box.

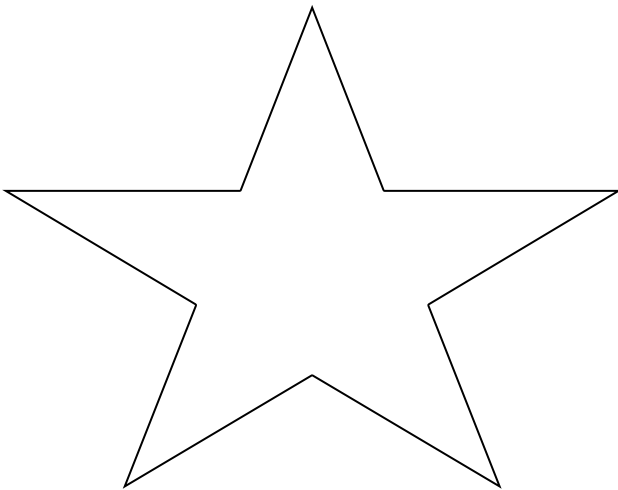
What animal is on the top of the Wellington memorial?

Sir Christopher Wren designed St Paul's after the old cathedral burned down in the Great Fire of London. **What year was the Great Fire?** When you go downstairs to the crypt, watch the film about it in the OCULUS film room.

huge gates! Go through them...

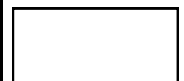


When you are through the gates

Look for symmetrical angels and patterns.

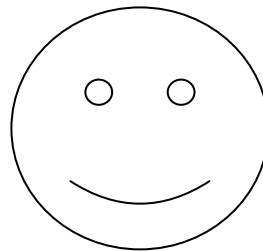
Look at the patterns in the arches up there too!

There are many more interesting things to find down there.

Floor mosaics

Wren's tomb at the back of the OBE Chapel and all the interesting things in that chapel...

The Duke of Wellington's enormous tomb...find the four lions!

Florence Nightingale's Memorial...what is she doing in the picture?

Lord Nelson's tomb...look for the cushion and crown on the top!

ANSWERS

Page 1. There is one lion on each lamp stand. There are twelve lions around Wellington's memorial. **Total: 14 lions!**

The animal on top of Wellington's memorial is a horse. This was his war horse.

Page 2. **We'll leave you to count those star points & colours under the dome AND the number of windows up in the dome...ha ha!**

There are 8 stone pillars holding up the dome arches.

The dome is a circle shape—although the dome itself is a hemisphere of course!

The Great Fire broke out in September 1666!

Page 4 Florence Nightingale is nursing a dying soldier in the Scutari hospital, during the Crimean war and is giving him a glass of water.

Don't forget to visit OCULUS in the crypt to watch the films about the Great Fire, The Blitz and the life of the cathedral today.
