Your seat has already been allocated according to the colour of your wristband:

Central Dome - Yellow


North Transept – Red

South Transept – Green

Nave - Blue

Nave Aisles & Standing - Purple

- Do not bring a bag if you can
 Only one small bag (max 40 cm x 20 cm x 25cm) is allowed.
- **Do not bring flowers or tributes** e.g. photos, candles, toys for security reasons
- Join the queue between from 15:00 in Paternoster Square. Entry to the queue closes at 16:00



MORE INFORMATION



What time does service start?

- The service starts at 18:00 and lasts for one hour
- The Cathedral is closed until the service begins
- Please join the queue in Paternoster Square from 15:00
- Please do not join the queue before this time
- Your position in the queue does not affect where you will sit. You will be assigned a seat when you enter St Paul's

Your Wristband



- Your wristband is your ticket for entry to the service
- If you take it off or give it to someone else it will not be valid
- Each colour wristband band matches a different seating area
- A steward will direct you to your seat when you enter



Entrance & access

- Please join the queue in Paternoster Square from 15:00.
- Do not arrive later than 16:00 or you may not be allowed in.
- Security searches for bags and guests will be taking place
- There is step-free access a steward will give you directions
- There is a hearing loop inside St Paul's



Baggage & prohibited items

- You can bring one carry bag per person into St Paul's
- Your bag should be no larger than 40 cm x 20 cm x 25 cm
- There is no cloakroom and you must keep your bag with you at all times
- A comprehensive search regime is in place and anything prohibited will be found
- Do not bring any prohibited items: Glass bottles, alcohol, hot drinks, knives or other sharp objects, climbing equipment, banners, claxons loud healers, fireworks or flares, drones, spray paint or tins of paint, scooters, or musical instruments. If you are found in possession of any of these articles, you may be refused admission; where appropriate the police will be immediately notified

- One New Change Shopping Centre (Postcode: EC4M 9AF)
- Once inside the Cathedral, toilets are available in the Crypt



Can I bring Flowers & Tributes?

Flowers and tributes e.g. photos, candles, toys will not be permitted inside St Paul's or laid outside of the Cathedral in the interests of safety and security
