This is the main entrance to the Cathedral.




If you are using a wheelchair, you might visit through this step free entrance.

They will be able to help you get a ticket and find your way around












Toilets Café/Eating Area Shop

Places you will see on your visit




Crypt



257 steps up

The Whispering Gallery is inside the cathedral and up towards the dome. The galleries are not wheelchair accessible. There are no photographs here. The Stone Gallery is outside. Here you can walk around the dome.
