

Diocesan Confirmation Service at St Paul's Cathedral Saturday 1st November 2025 at 5pm

Clergy are welcome to present candidates either for Confirmation, or Confirmation with Baptism, or Reception into the Church of England. Those wishing to present candidates are asked to contact the Liturgical Department, at the Chapter House or at confirmations@stpaulscathedral.org.uk by **12pm on Friday 10th October** please – the earlier the better. It is essential that we receive this information by the deadline to ensure that the relevant details can be published in the Order of Service and passed on to the confirming Bishop.

It is your responsibility to ensure that each of your candidates completes and returns the Confirmation form by **12pm on Friday 10th October**.

Forms are available via the website on this page: stpauls.co.uk/worship-music/worship/confirmations. Due to the administrative requirements associated with this service, only those candidates whose completed forms are received by **Friday 10th October** will be confirmed in this service. Forms received after this date cannot be processed and therefore such candidates will not be included in the Confirmation this year.

The rehearsal will take place at 3pm on Saturday 1st November. Please come with your candidates, meeting under the Dome for a walk through. The rehearsal will start promptly and will last around an hour. **Please allow plenty of time to arrive, to get to the right part of the Cathedral and be ready to start at 3pm.** It is unfair on the candidates if they miss part of the rehearsal, and spend the service worrying about where to be and what to do.

Please bring along your completed Confirmation Register. You are required to fill this in and bring it to be signed by the Bishop.

For those candidates who are also being Baptised, their Baptism will be recorded in the St Paul's Baptism Register.

Certificates will be issued on the day to all candidates. Please ensure your candidates provide their full names when completing the Confirmation form.

Presenting Clergy (one from each parish) are invited to robe. Vesture for this service is surplice and white stole.
